The Safety Day theme promotes engagement of the One Plan, an "all-hazards" planning approach to safely stop problems when they are small while also avoiding injury or catastrophic loss from any emergency encountered - we call it "resiliency for business continuation."

The One Plan Ammonia Coalition is made up of IIAR, RETA, ASTI, IARW and ARF, their logos are on the header of this message. The Safety Day program is loaded with great emergency responder information brought to you for FREE by of the One Plan Coalition and the Safety Day sponsors and host. The training format includes many exciting and engaging simulations and break-out sessions that highlight key components of the One Plan, which includes the use of system controls to engage defensive emergency incident control, use of glove box emergency responder checklists, and methods of engaging a unified approach while working with public safety to control and contain an emergency event. By the end of the day attendees will understand the value of applying prevention, mitigation, and preparedness to achieve effective emergency response. Our presenter will be Ron King of NIA. Ron will present on:

Insulation and corrosion, corrosion under insulation (CUI), has been debated for years. Does mechanical insulation cause corrosion or can insulation help prevent corrosion? The debate continues.

Corrosion under insulation in below ambient conditions and especially ammonia refrigeration could be extremely problematic. Selecting and correctly installing the proper insulation is critical to the longevity of the insulation system and the substrate and the operating process. But that is an only piece to the puzzle. You may think you have heard this story before, but now you can get the "rest of the story. The benefits of mechanical insulation are multiple faceted, like improving plant safety, increasing plant productivity, extending the life of refrigeration and process equipment, improvements in the plant environment, avoiding regulatory concerns and understanding the extensive damage that could be created with standard non-destructive testing methods and weather related damage. The bottom line, implementing an insulation timely – effective maintenance program is a "low-hanging fruit" decision, especially when you what to prevent corrosion.

The presentation will explore the many benefits of insulation and the insulation – corrosion subject and how corrosion can be prevented, providing you think about insulation differently.
